Changes to our timetable

Following discussions with Government and the wider rail industry, Great Western Railway is reducing services to reflect national advice against non-essential travel, while maintaining services critical to keeping key workers moving during the current situation.

The changes prioritise key routes essential for those people continuing to deliver vital services as the UK responds to the current situation.

Changes since last week

This is version 1 for this week, produced 26 March at 2230. The following changes have been made since last week:

- * Although general frequency remains the same, many services run at different times to last week. Check carefully before you travel
- * Planned engineering work between Exeter and Barnstaple mean that those services are replaced by buses. This is subject to change.
- * The line between Salisbury and Romsey has been re-opened, and trains now run through to Portsmouth Harbour again
- * The line between Castle Cary and Taunton has been re-opened, and trains now run hourly between London and Plymouth via the regular route again
- * Fewer trains call at Appleford and Culham
- * Most London to Worcester trains will terminate at Shrub Hill
- * Taunton to Cardiff Central trains will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads
- * Bristol Temple Meads to Great Malvern trains will terminate at Gloucester
- * Westbury to Weymouth service is reduced to 3 trains a day
- * Many smaller changes are not listed here, so if you need to travel, please check your journey carefully at **GWR.com/Check**

All tickets will be valid for use on all operator's services on that route.
